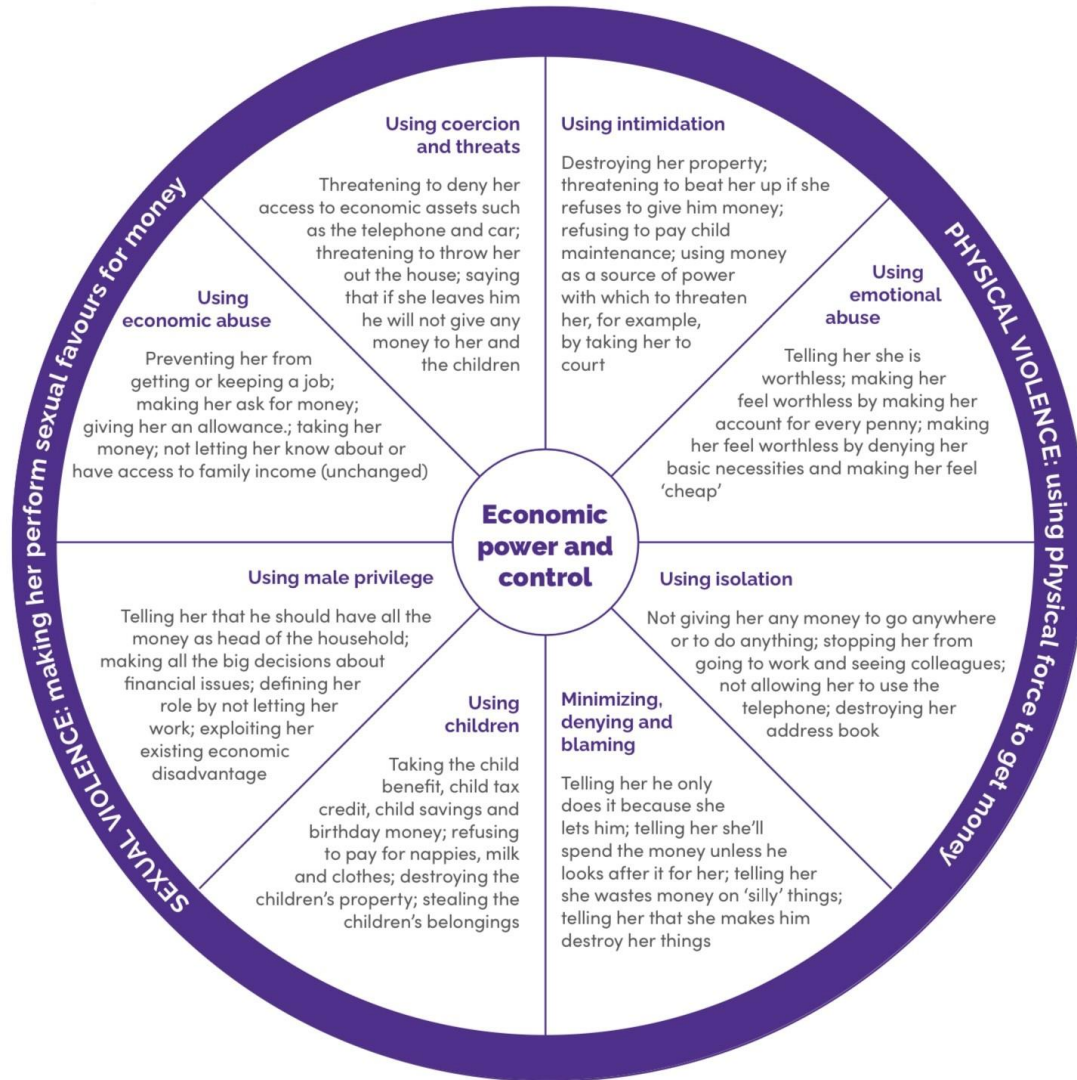

# Economic abuse definition (Domestic Abuse Act, 2021)

Any **behaviour** that has a substantial and adverse effect on the victim-survivors ability to –

a) acquire, use or maintain **money or other property**, or

b) obtain **goods or services**

**Behaviour:** economic control – restriction, exploitation and/or sabotage.

**Property:** would cover items such as a mobile phone, or car.

**Goods or services:** would cover, for example, utilities such as heating, or items such as food or clothing.
